USSF League Games – 3 man vs 2 man system

- A reminder that all USSF affiliated games require the 3 man diagonal system of control.
- Using the 2 man system renders your USSF referee liability insurance as ***null and void***.
- **DO NOT USE** the 2 man system for any IWSL, NISL, or YSSL game.

USSF Referee fees / payment

Following are some guidelines and do's / don'ts of receiving your pay for doing IWSL, NISL, and YSSL games. RASO expects you to abide by these guidelines.

- You get paid only for the position that you do, center or AR.
- If a certified referee is not used as an AR, no one gets paid for the open line.
- If a non-certified person is used as a club lineperson, no one gets paid for the line.
- No combination pay allowed.
- Do not sign someone else's name / code onto a NISL game card, unless the actual person worked the entire game.
- Payment amounts are listed on the RASO website for the various leagues and ages.
